Matters arising from December's management meeting

We will be purchasing a small shed to house and locate the dust extractor outside the wood-turning sea container.

We were unsuccessful in getting a grant for the establishment of a community garden but will try again in the next round. This also means that the purchase of a third sea container needs to be delayed as will the move of the main dust extractor to outside the back wall of the workshop.

U3A have hired of our meeting room in February and March 2024, which means some income to help offset our running costs.
